ULTIMATELY, THE GOAL OF THE SALMON ENHANCEMENT PROJECT IS TO MAKE THE PUBLIC AMARE OF THE PROBLEMS THAT ARISE THROUGH DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIALIZATION. THEY HOPE TO MOTIVATE THE PUBLIC TO SUPPORT LEGISLATION PROTECTING OUR NATURAL SURROUNDINGS WHILE THERE IS STILL TIME. THE STUDENTS INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT MANT CITIZENS TO HAVE A REALIZATION OF MART COULD BE DEVELOPING NOW SO THAT WE CAN PREPARE FOR THE FUTURE

JURNITA STUDENTS MAY HAVE TO WORK HARDER TO EARN AN "A" GRADE THIS YEAR ONE REASON FOR THIS CHANGE COULD BE DUE TO THE FACT THAT MOST OF THE SCHOOL HAS GONE BACK TO THE TRADITIONAL FULL CREDIT SYSTEM. WITH THIS CHANGE MANY TEACHERS HAVE REVISED THEIR GRADING POLICIES. IN DOING SO STUDENTS MAY ACHIEVE FULL CREDIT WITH ONLY 68%. OF THE SEMESTER'S WORK. THE CUTS HAVE ALSO AFFECTED THE SCHOOL'S BUDGET IN SUCH A WAY THAT THERE ARE FEMER LIBRARY BOOKS FOR RESEARCH. AND LESS PAPER FOR CLASSROOM HANDOUTS. FINALLY, CHANGES ON THE BUDGET HAVE DECREASED TEACHER AIDE TIME, WHICH IN TURN DECREASES SIDDENT-TEACHER CONTACT. THIS GIVES STUDENTS LESS TIME TO DISCUSS DIFFICULTIES THEY MAY BE HAVING.

DUE TO CREDIT CHANGES AND BUDGET CUTS, WORK NILL BE DIFFERENT FOR THE STUDENT RSPIRING TO A HIGH G.P.A. OR PERSONAL SATISFACTION THESE STUDENTS WILL FIND THAT IN-CLASS NOTETAKING, ADDITIONAL PROJECTS, EXTRA READING, AND OUTSIDE STUDIES, WILL ALL BE NECESSARY TO ACIEVE THE ALLUSIVE "A".

### The Unkindest Cut of All

BUDGET REDUCTIONS ARE THE FATHER OF FRUSTRATIONS THEY FORCE PEOPLE TO ELIMINATE PROGRAMS WHICH ARE OFTEN ESSENTIAL. ARE THESE CUTS REALLY NECESSARY?

THE RVERAGE STUDENT IS NOT AWARE OF THE RERSONS WAY BUDGET CUTS ARE BEING MADE. SINCE THE REDUCTIONS RFFECT STUDENTS DIRECTLY, AND UNFRVORABLY AS WELL. THE AVERAGE STUDENT SHOULD DEMAND TO KNOW WAY THESE BUDGET CUTS ARE NECESSARY. THERE ARE BRSIDALLY THREE REASONS:

1) ON THE NATIONAL LEVEL PRESIDENT REAGAN IS DETERMINED THAT HE WILL BALANCE THE FEDERAL BUDGET THIS YEAR. OR IN OTHER WORDS, PROVIDE FOR THE SIZABLE INCREASE IN MILITARY SPENDING. TO DO THIS, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAS CHANGED IT'S METHOD OF FUNDING. IN THE PRST, FUNDING WAS DIVIDED INTO CATEGORIES LIKE SPECIAL EDUCATION. ATHLETICS, SUPPLIES, ETC ... UNDER THE NEW BUDGET A BLOCK GRANT IS GIVEN. A BLOCK GRANT'S AN AMOUNT OF NONEY UNCHTROORIZED. A GRANT IS GIVEN TO EACH STATE TO HELP THEN PROVIDE FOR THEIR SCHOOL SYSTEMS. THE STATE LEGISLATURE THEN DECIDE HOW UNFORTUNATELY, THE GRANT GIVEN TO DIVIDE IT. ALLONS FOR LESS SPENDING THRM IN THE PRST.

2) ON THE STATE LEVEL, THE LEGISLATURE HAS REDUCED THE AMOUNT THAT THE STATE CONTRIBUTES TOMARDS BASIC EDUCATION. THIS IS PARTIALLY DUE TO THE NEN TREND TOMARDS CONSERVATIVISM IN THE LEGISLATURE. ALSO THERE IS A NEED TO EQUALIZE SMALLER SCHOOL DISTRICTS SO THAT THEY WILL RECEIVE AS MUCH NONEY PER STUDENT AS LARGER DISTRICTS.



Solar Greenhouse Is For Everyone

THE SOLAR GREENHOUSE IS A PROJECT WHICH PROVIDES UNIQUE "HANDS ON" LEARNING EXPERIENCE FOR JUANITA STUDENTS. IN 1978, KEITH RANAGE. LISA WAYO, AND LISA KENNAN, JUANITA STUDENTS, SUBMITTED THEIR DESIGNS FOR THE GREENHOUSE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY. IN RETURN THEY RECEIVED A \$28,000 GRANT. LAKE WASHINGTON VOC-TECH AND LOCAL INDUSTRY HAVE ALSO OFFERED THEIR SUPPORT. CONSTRUCTION BEGAN IN SEPTEMBER OF 1979.

THE PROJECT INVOLVES SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS AT JURNITA THOSE INVOLVED INCLUDE: REBEL DESIGN REBEL GRAPHICS, PHOTOGRAPHY, PHYSICS, REBEL CONSTRUCTION, PROJECT LANGURGE ARTS, HORTICULTURE, ACCOUNTING, LEADERSHIP, DEVELOPMENTAL MATH. OVERALL THE PROJECT INVOLVES OVER TWO HUNDRED STUDENTS. THE EXPERIENCE GRINED BY INVOLVEMENT WITH THE GREENHOUSE IS INVALUABLE. RECRINCE IT IS DEAL THE STUDENT TO COMPONENTION CONDITIONING OUR STUDENTS TO BE PARIOTIC. THE XNRZIS IN GERMANY HAD SIMILAR LANS, AND THE COMMUNISTS IN THE SOVIET UNION TODAY HAVE ,COMPULSORY ALLEGIANCE LANS. IN OUR COUNTRY, FREEDOM SHOULD TAKE PRIORITY.

THE STATE IS TRYING TO FORCE US TO SALUTE THE #FLAG. BUT THE MAIN REASON WE DO CHOOSE TO SALUTE THE FLAG IS BECAUSE WE AREN'T FORCED TO. WE ARE PLEDGING ALLEGIANCE TO A FREE COUNTRY. A COUNTRY OF FREE CHOICE—NOT A COUNTRY OF FORCED SUBMISSION. IT NOULD BE PERFECTLY ALL RIGHT IF IT MEREN'T A LAW OR IT MEREN'T REQUIRED. IT MOULD BE PERFECTLY ALL RIGHT IF WERE STRICTLTY VOLUNTARY. BUT AS THE LAW NOW STANDS, BEING A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT, I FEEL THE RIGHTS OF ALL THE STUDENTS AND ALL THE TEACHERS ARE BEING STAMPED ON BY A ONCE-AGAIN OPPRESSIVE GOVERNMENT. OUR COUTRY MUST STAY FREE WE DON'T MEED TO RETURN. TO MCCARTHYISM.

IF OUR GOVERNMENT WERE LET LOOSE, IT COULD MAKE LAWS REGUIRING ORTHS AND HONOR PLEDGES IN THE CLASSROOM, OR EVEN PERCETIME COMPULSORY NILITARY SERVICE, ALL IN THE NAME OF OUR COUNTRY AND PATRIOTISM. 




